CLARIFICATION ON THE STATUS OF THE OLD ONDO STATE
PENSION BOARD FOLLOWING THE SIGNING INTO LAW OF THE
NEW ONDO STATE PENSION REFORM LAW 2014

As you are already aware that Contributory Pension Scheme came into effect in Ondo State Public Service, sequel to the signing into Law, the State's Pension Reform Law, 2014 by the Governor of Ondo State, Dr. Olusegun Mimiko. Accordingly, by the provisions of Section 76 of the Pension Reform Law 2014, the Pension Law Cap 90, Law of Ondo State, 1978 and Ondo State Pension Board Law, 2001, have since been repealed. The

implication of this development, in line with the new Law is that, the **Ondo State Pension Board** has ceased to exist as a Board.

2. However, in order to ensure efficient service delivery to retirees under the Old Defined Benefit Scheme (DBS), and in replacement for the defunct Ondo State Pension Board, Section 42 of the Ondo State Pension Reform Law 2014, provides for the establishment of Ondo State Pension Transitional Department.

3. Flowing from above, therefore, I wish to inform you that Ondo State Pension Board has formally been changed from Ondo State Pension Board to **Ondo State Pension Transitional Department**, in line with the Ondo State Pension Reform Law 2014. As provided under Section 42 (2) of the Law, the Pension Department will coordinate both the Civil and Teaching Service Pension which will now be superintended by the Office of the Head of Service.

4. In effect, you are to kindly note this change of name in your dealings with this Office. Particularly, all correspondence should be address as **Ondo State Pension Transitional Department, Office of the Head of Service, Oke-Eda, Akure, Ondo State, Nigeria.**

5. Accounting Officers are therefore enjoined to give the content of this Circular Letter necessary publicity it deserves in their respective Ministries/Departments and Agencies (MDAs), please.
